- 2 CYCLES empowers Child and Youth Care Practitioners to act as financial literacy and entrepreneurship mentors, pass on their skills and help establish favourable conditions for further capacity building.

MAIN OUTCOMES

The **CYCLES training**, which is going to consist of 6 modules focusing on financial literacy and entrepreneurship skills for child and youth care practitioners and respectively young care leavers to increase knowledge on the core topics.

The **CYCLES Transferability and Evaluation Handbook**, which ensures that the CYCLES training materials created will be thoughtfully implemented to other countries or to other parts of the participating countries to increase the knowledge on financial literacy and entrepreneurship needed by the primary and secondary target group.
